 - **Height:** A minimum of 5'6" is required.
 - **Chest Measurements:** Chest girth must be at least 32 inches unexpanded and 33.5 inches expanded.
- **Physical Standards for Females:**
 - **Height:** A minimum height of 5'2" is mandatory.
- **Relaxation in Physical Standard:**

For the candidates belonging to Height shall be relaxable by 2".

 - **Shot Put (4 Kgs):** Achieve a throw distance of at least 14.5 feet within three attempts. Precision and power will be essential here, as specified in the JKP Constable Syllabus.
