- 2. Register as a new user if you haven't already, and log in.
- 3. Fill out the **online application form** with correct details.
- 4. Upload required documents like a photo, signature, and caste certificate (if applicable).
- 5. Double-check the details and submit the form.
- 6. Save and download the confirmation for future reference.

JKP Sub inpector: E ligibelity Criteria and Syllabus

To be eligible for the JK Police SI Recruitment 2024, candidates must meet the following requirements:

- Educational Qualification: Candidates must have a graduation degree from a recognized university or institution.
- Age Limit (as of 1st January 2024): Candidates should be between the ages of **18 to 28 years**. Age relaxation is applicable for reserved categories.

Selection Process

The selection process for JK Police SI includes:

- 1. Written Examination: An objective-type exam to test general knowledge and reasoning skills.
- 2. Physical Standard Test (PST): Measurement of height, chest, etc.
- 3. Physical Endurance Test (PET): Includes physical tasks like running and push-ups.
- 4. Document Verification: All documents and certificates will be verified.
- 5. **Medical Examination**: A standard medical test to ensure physical fitness.

- Physical Standard Test (PST): Height and chest measurements.
- Physical Endurance Test (PET):
 - Male candidates: 1600 meters run in 6 minutes 30 seconds, 20 push-ups.
 - Female candidates: 1000 meters run in 6 minutes 30 seconds, 14.5 feet shot put.

Application Fees

Candidates are required to pay the following application fees based on their category:

• General/OBC/Unreserved: Rs. 700/-

• SC, ST-1, ST-2, and EWS: Rs. 600/-

The payment can only be made through **online modes**, such as net banking or debit/credit cards.

Salary and Benefits

The selected candidates for the JK Police SI position will receive a salary in the pay scale of Rs. 35,700/- to Rs. 1,13,100/- under Level 6C as per the 7th Pay Commission.
